Entry Fees: \$50 for competition and/or either clinic

Registration is by individual. You may participate in multiple teams and either clinic for the one fee. You can register online at www.dcjudo.com/FayeAllen. A kata team (same uke and tori) may perform once in each kata. If two individuals wish to compete twice in the same kata, the roles of uke and tori must change, or one person can be paired with another individual to make a new team. A team cannot compete in two divisions for the same kata (e.g., not Novice and advanced).

Nage-no-Kata, Katame-no-Kata, and Ju-no-Kata Divisions:

Novice: Both partners must be Ikkyu or below, or one partner may be black belt when the other is Yonkyu or below. Teams perform the first two sets of Ju no and Katame; first three sets of Nage.

Advanced: Open to any team. Will perform the entire kata.

International: Teams that have competed together and placed at Nationals or International events

Note: There is no junior division. Junior kata competitors holding junior ranks count as senior yonkyu and below when determining divisions (i.e. Novice). Junior competitors holding senior ranks should use their senior ranks when determining divisions.

If your team needs to demonstrate less than the expected number of sets, you **will** be permitted to do so. Please contact the tournament director and state what you can demonstrate on your registration form.

Goshin Jutsu & Kime-no-Kata Divisions:

Advanced: Open to any team. All teams perform the entire kata.

International: Teams that have competed together and placed at Nationals or International events
